- Carefully read this application form before completion. You should supply all the information required – otherwise your application may be returned for completion. You are advised that a false or misleading statement will invalidate any permit issued.
- The types of permit available are listed below.
- Hunting permits should be carried on your person at all times when you are hunting or attempting to hunt.
- Hunting is not permitted on land or water that at any stage is declared subject to native title.
- All Duck hunters must have successfully passed the Waterfowl Identification Test (WIT) prior to hunting ducks during the open season.

**WARNING: ON EXPIRATION OF YOUR PERMIT, THE ONUS IS ON YOU TO RENEW.** While the Fauna Permit Unit issues renewal notices, it will not be responsible for the non-receipt of such a notice.

\*Please note: RESTRICTED DUCK SEASON from 19 February to 26 June 2011. Bag limit of 12 ducks per hunter per day. Maximum of 6 Pacific Black Ducks per hunter per day. The season is CLOSED for the Australasian (Blue-winged) shoveler (*Anas rhynchos*).

RESTRICTED QUAIL SEASON from 2 April to 31 July 2011 with a bag limit of 20 stubble quail per hunter per day.

Class 2, 4, 6, 8, 9, 10 permits can be issued only after the declaration of a season and during a season. Open season permits will be not available at the end of a season.
